The Mat-Su Borough, City of Wasilla and Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, have been working together on three projects to connect roads, ease congestion, and make driving in the area safer for residents and visitors. Come to an open house to learn more about these projects and the Alaska Department of Transportation's project, Parks Highway, milepost 44-52.



The Mat-Su Borough's Parks Highway Connectors project will extend Machen Road eastward and Museum Drive westward as Parks Highway frontage roads. Help the project team identify impacts arising from these projects on area residents and businesses, and brainstorm ways to mitigate them.



The City of Wasilla has started a project to study the extension of South Mack Drive to KGB Road. When complete, this road will provide another north-south connection to the Parks Highway. Help the project team select the route.



The ADOT&PF project to upgrade the Parks Highway from milepost 44 to milepost 52 to a 4-lane divided highway with limited access is in the preliminary design and environmental documentation phase. The project area is a Traffic Safety Corridor due to the high rate of fatal and severe injury crashes in the area.

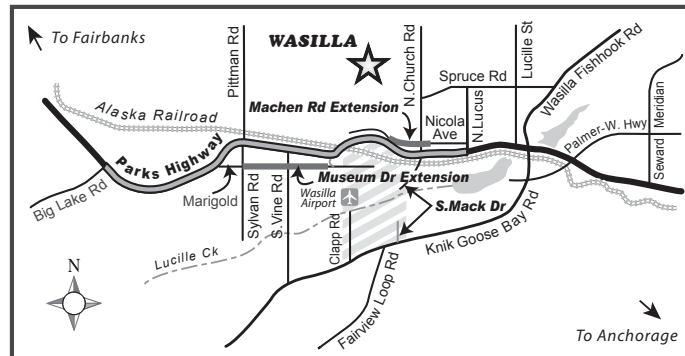
